In his role at Chicago CRED, Paul helps support staff across multiple community sites on the South and Westside, directly overseeing the Employment & Training, Housing, Education, and Court Referral Programs.

Prior to CRED, Paul worked for several school-based violence prevention initiatives, including B.A.M. (Becoming A Man), an evidence-based mentorship program. Paul earned an MA from the University of Chicago and a BA from Fairfield University. He was a 2019 Fellow at the University of Chicago's Civic Leadership Academy.
